Learn what daily life is like for the locals and, at the same time, share your faith through relational outreach in the community.

Experience what God is doing through the many departments of Love Botswana and be an active part of the transformation taking place in the region. As you participate in the work of Kingdom-building, you will discover more about missionary life overseas and grow personally in the potential God has placed within you.

Missions Immersion Program



Month 1:
Cultural Immersion

The initial training for Missions Immersion interns will culturally prepare you for the coming months in the field. Each week, you will hear directly from experienced missionaries, pastors, or ministry leaders. These classes and discussion groups will cover:

- African Culture
- Ministry in Africa
- Missionary Experiences
- Training in "bush-craft" or wilderness skills such as use of tools, fire-building, etc.

Opportunities for serving at Love Botswana Outreach Mission will be assigned, providing mentorship in addition to the training sessions. These ministry assignments are determined based on need, with as much consideration as possible given to each intern's interest and abilities.

Month 2: Practical Application

During the second month, interns are assigned to one of the 8 branch churches associated with Love Botswana Outreach Mission. These local faith communities are pastored by alumni from the Love Botswana Bible Institute and are closely connected to our ministry and the Village Church in Maun.

You will be hosted by a branch church leader and his family. Individual assignments will include all aspects of rural church life, such as evangelism, outreach, praise and worship, and ministries specific to the area in which the branch church is located. You will have the opportunity to process your experiences with fellow interns, internship leaders, and Village Church staff upon returning to the LBOM Campus.

The above map provides a general idea of the proximity of branch churches to our main campus in Maun.

Month 3: Integration & Debriefing

Your final month focuses on local ministry in Maun through the various programs and outreaches of the Village Church. Ministry assignment options include evangelism and discipleship opportunities with:

- Men's or Women's Ministry
- Young Adults
- Youth (including purity clubs called Reach4Life)
- Children
- Prison Outreach

Additionally, you could assist during worship services in a variety of ways, such as greeting, ushering, or participating in the praise and worship team.

At the conclusion of the internship, your team will enjoy an adventure trip together to explore Africa. This trip is included in the total cost of the internship and allows a time to debrief as a group.

Cost of Program: \$5300

(includes transportation from Atlanta, GA, as well as all internship expenses) Personal spending and excursions outside the program will be at your own expense.

Applications are received online.

There is an application fee of \$40 for processing and a criminal background check.
